The Telecaster Mod Guide - Premier Guitar

Guitar wiring refers to the electrical components, and interconnections thereof, inside an electric guitar (and, by extension, other electric instruments like the bass guitar or mandolin). It most commonly consists of pickups, potentiometers to adjust volume and tone, a switch to select between different pickups (if the instrument has more than one), and the output socket.

Now that we've analyzed the Telecaster "dark circuit" that Fender used from mid 1952 up to late 1967 ["Factory Telecaster Wirings, Pt. 1," August 2013], it's time to explore the Tele wiring that was introduced after 1967. This wiring is referred to as the "modern" or "standard" Telecaster wiring and is still in use today.

Two common types of 5-way switches... The questions I get asked in response to people reading my stuff on guitar wiring often relate to the 5-way pickup selector switch so I thought I'd write a brief explanation of how it works.

Okay - no panic - a friend lent me his guitar loaded with the EMG RPC and SPC controls and of course I traced and measured them - i have pictures and I have layouts etc - up in a few days - I built an RPC control and installed it in one of my strats (the one with two EMG81 pickups etc.) and I have to say it works very well in sharpening the top end response to mimic a more Telecaster type of tone.
